## COMMITTEE REPORTS

**COUNCILMAN WILLIAM GLEASON:** The Optimist Senior Bingo is this upcoming Sunday. He also stated he had a meeting with the Department of Public Works, in addition to assisting them install a barrier around the Center Street playground, with mulch expected to be delivered shortly. He further mentioned the upcoming cheesecake fundraiser and Landfill Advisory Meeting that will take place at 6pm before the next Land Use Board meeting.

**COUNCILMAN KEVIN MCCORMACK:** Spoke with the Gorsica's to see the status of the outfall piping replacement, and stated they are happy with the Borough's progress thus far. He further stated interest in re-stripping the municipal complex parking lot for safety reasons during Court. He had a meeting with the Department of Public Works to discuss preparedness with snow, and plans to purchase new Western plows at the request of DPW, in addition to new safety uniforms.

**COUNCILMAN MURRAY:** Currently in contract negotiations with the Department of Public Works. He is in continual contact with the Police Department and most recently updated on some raids in and around Belmont. Additionally, he informed the Governing Body that he attended and spoke at the most recent Toms River Regional Schools System to bring to their attention his displeasure with the lack of safety protocols for their improvement project at the South Toms River Elementary School.

**COUNCILWOMAN MOSLEY:** Spoke on her support of addressing safety concerns at the South Toms River Elementary School, and thanked Councilman Murray.
