NEW BUSINESS

Environmental Coastal Monitoring (ECM) Program

Borough Administrator stated this program by the New Jersey Cooperative Coastal Monitoring Program (NJ's Beach Program). From mid-May through September, local health agencies monitor public recreational bathing beach water quality and post the result at: njbeaches.org. The website also includes current beach status, beach advisories and beach closings, reports, information on other events that affect beaches and daily updates from our coastal surveillance flights. In the past, this Program included monitoring at environmental stations. Environmental stations are located in areas where primary recreation routinely occurs, but not at a regulated recreational bathing beach. Environmental monitoring stations were removed from the program in 2007 due to funding constraints.

Borough Administrator spoke to pending Building Inspection Legislation: A4850/S3095. The purpose of the Legislation is to allow contractors to pay a premium fee for inspections to be conducted on off hours and within two days from when the request was made or to hire outside entities to conduct inspections

2 critical problems:

- Regulations currently exist mandating that collected fees be dedicated to inspections and inspections take place within three days see, NJAC 5:23-4.17(c)
- The reality is that there is a shortage of certified inspectors employed by municipalities for a variety of reasons and DCA needs to address this shortfall

FY 2021 Local Recreation Improvement Grant

Borough Administrator stated that the Borough Engineer is checking for specifics regarding what will and will not qualify under the grant. The Mechanical engineer will evaluate the existing HVAC system
