TAYLOR: Great Football Camp. Thank you to Sam Fennell for helping. Youth Day is June 12th, and expect this to be a great event as well. He would like to have scholarships for the upcoming Summer Camp. There are plans for a 5K run and 1 mile walk to raise money for community programs.

MOSLEY: Attended the Recreation Commission meeting. Thanked everyone for their work at events.

ROLZHAUSEN: Attended a Land Use Board Meeting; the Borough-wide Yard Sale went well; The Police Committee met, and there is a new certified list. The Police have also been conducting SLEO II interviews. They also discussed a new upcoming law on certified police hires.

Trips are being finalized, and will include a lunch program that will be sent home with kids at the end of each camp day. The Camp will run from 9am to 1pm, and goes till June 30th.

SUEZ correspondence: Due to this past week/weekend’s heat and dry spell, SUEZ issued an auto call, system wide (all of Toms River, SToms River, Berkeley) this evening requesting that customers conserve water and refrain from non-essential water usage in order to help the community meet water demand without placing further strain on the water system.

The Borough Administrator mentioned that he is obtaining quotes for tick and mosquito spray at two locations: The ballfields at the Recreation Building and Brook Forest Drive playground.
